- Lone Palm offers a full banquet menu for all your food and beverage needs. From time to time, charities will receive donated food and beverage on the golf course. All donated food and beverage arrangements need to be approved by General Manager. To cover the opportunity cost incurred by the club for donated product, the event will be billed as follows:
 - Donated Course Beer: \$4.95 (+ 18% service charge) per player
 - Donated Course Soft Drinks: \$3.95 (+ 18% service charge) per player
 - Donated Beer and Soft Drinks: \$6.95 (+ 18% service charge) per player
 - Donated Continental Breakfast: \$3.95 per player
 - Donated Lunch: \$5.95 per player
- All events must be sponsored by a member and have at least one member participate in the event.
- Tax exempt charities need to submit Consumer's Certificate of Exemption prior to event.
